<u>DIRECTIONS TO WESTDENE WALK</u> (<u>MELVILLE KOPPIES EAST</u>)

Drive along Barry Hertzog, direction south.

Go through the set of traffic lights at Judith Road (Emmarentia) Take the next right.

This is Rustenburg Road – no traffic lights but the first road to the right after the Judith Road traffic lights.

Follow Rustenburg Road still heading south towards the centre of town –.

You will be traveling parallel to Barry Herzog and a bit of a windy section.

(LANDMARK – big BP filing station and white ADMARK building)

Then turn right into 8th Avenue Almost immediately turn right again into Hill Street Parking in Hill Street.

PLEASE NOTE: The Melville Koppies "split" Hill Street. Please make sure you are on the Melville side of Hill Street – and the Melville side of the koppie.

If by mistake you find yourself on the Emmarentia part of Hill Street, you will find yourself at the top of the koppie looking down on where you should be. If it happens, follow the road around the koppie (Hill – Sabie – Rustenburg) and you are right back on track to the meeting point Rustenburg – 8th – lower section of Hill We suggest you wear takkies, take water, hats, sunblock, and a snack. Your dogs will have a super time!
